**Example:** *Night* by Elie Wiesel

This scene shows how horrible the Germans treated the Jews, and how they don’t even care if they live or not. To that officer, it would probably be easier if all those people died, because then it would make his job a little easier. This quote reminds me of when someone that doesn’t like you always looks for things to torment you with.
